ORDINANCE 02-96

ORDINANCE PROHIBITING ROLLER BLADES
AND SIMILAR DEVICES FROM CERTAIN PUBLIC SIDEWALKS

WHEREAS, Spanish Fork City owns and maintains public sidewalks in, upon, abutting and fronting public parks, public facilities, recreational facilities and certain commercial zones; and

WHEREAS, numerous pedestrians use these sidewalks to access ball games, libraries, picnics, and other related activities; and

WHEREAS, numerous pedestrians use the public sidewalks in the C-2 zone along main street between 100 South and 400 North and in the SC-1 zones in order to access various stores and commercial ventures; and

WHEREAS, there has recently been an increase in individuals using roller blades, roller skates, skateboards, and similar devices on the public sidewalks in those areas frequented by pedestrians, which causes a hazard to both pedestrians and individuals using said devices; and

WHEREAS, in order to protect the health safety and welfare of the residents, it is necessary to restrict roller blades, skateboards, and roller skates from public sidewalks in certain areas;

NOW THEREFORE, be it ordained and enacted by the Spanish Fork City Council as follows:


1. Section 12.04.055 of the Spanish Fork Municipal Code is hereby created to read as follows:

12.04.055 Prohibited Activities on Sidewalks.

It is unlawful to use roller blades, skates, skateboards, or similar devices on the public sidewalks in, and adjacent to, abutting, or in front of public parks, public facilities, recreational facilities, the C-2 zone fronting Main Street between 100 South and 400 North, and any SC-1 zone.


