ORDINANCE 04-96
ORDINANCE
AMENDING
SECTION 2.08.100
OF THE SPANISH
FORK CITY
MUNICIPAL CODE

WHEREAS, Spanish Fork City maintains a municipal code that deals with the power and duties and similar functions of the city council; and

WHEREAS, in establishing rules and regulations concerning the city council, the city is bound by parameters of state law; and

WHEREAS, it becomes necessary from time to time to amend various sections of the code in order to remain in compliance with state law;

NOW THEREFORE, be it ordained and enacted by the Spanish Fork City Council as follows:

Section I: Section

2.08.100 of the Spanish Fork City Municipal Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

2.08.100 Vacancies.

If any vacancy occurs in the office of a city council member, such vacancy shall be filled by appointment by the city council. The appointment shall be good until the next municipal election. The city will follow the requirements of state law in making any such appointment.

Section II:

WHEREFORE, to protect the safety and welfare of the citizens of

Spanish Fork City, this ordinance shall take effect immediately upon passage.
