ORDINANCE 07-96

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING
THE REQUIREMENTS CONCERNING
BUSINESS LICENSES**

WHEREAS, Spanish Fork City licenses and regulates various types of business activities through the issuance of business licenses; and

WHEREAS, the city sponsors a local celebration known as Fiesta Days which coincides with the State holiday on the 24th of July; and

WHEREAS, the local celebration has grown to the extent that it may continue more than four days; and

WHEREAS, the current Spanish Fork Municipal Code concerning business licenses prohibits the issuance of itinerant merchant licenses or canvasser or solicitor licenses from July 21, through July 25; and

WHEREAS, in order protect the investment of those supporting the City sponsored Fiesta Days, it is expedient and prudent that the limitation, be expanded throughout the entirety of the Fiesta Days celebration; and

WHEREAS, in order to protect the health, welfare and safety of the residents of the City it is necessary to make certain amendments to the Spanish Fork City ordinance concerning business licenses;

NOW THEREFORE, be it ordained and enacted by the Spanish Fork City Council as follows:

- I. Section 5.04.110 the Spanish Fork Municipal Code is hereby Amended as follows:

 - D. Where the business is that of an itinerant merchant, the license fee shall be one hundred dollars per day unless proceeds from the sale of any merchandise shall be returned to or used for the purpose of a charitable or otherwise non-taxed institution with permanent and substantial ties to the community. Such institutions shall include, but not be limited to, churches, scouting organizations, schools, local associations and service clubs. In the latter event, the license fee shall be five dollars (\$5.00) per day. The maximum license fee in any calendar year is three hundred dollars (\$300.00). No itinerant merchant license shall be issued or valid during the period

of the Fiesta Days celebration.

F. The amount for a business license for a canvasser or a solicitor shall be twenty-five dollars (\$25.00) per day per person. The maximum license in any calendar year is three hundred dollars (\$300.00) per person. No canvasser or solicitor license shall be issued or valid during the period of the Fiesta Days celebration.





NOW THEREFORE, be it ordained and enacted by the Spanish Fork City Council as follows:
