ORDINANCE 10-96

**AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING THE USE OF FIREWORKS
IN CERTAIN AREAS OF SPANISH FORK CITY**

WHEREAS, Spanish Fork City has various areas which constitute forest, range, or watershed lands; and

WHEREAS, the spring and early summer of 1996 has been extremely hot and dry, leaving the forest, range, or watershed lands in a condition of extreme fire danger; and

WHEREAS, the 4th of July and the 24th of July have periods when the use of fireworks are allowed by State law; and

WHEREAS, the Spanish Fork City Council finds that the use of fireworks, given the current conditions, constitutes a fire hazard to the forest, range, or watershed areas of the city; and

WHEREAS, a fire in these areas would constitute a serious threat to life and property; and

WHEREAS, in order to protect the health, safety, and welfare of the residents of the city, it is necessary to impose restrictions on the use of fireworks in those areas which would constitute a danger to life, property, forests, range, or watershed within the city;


NOW THEREFORE, be it enacted and ordained by the Spanish Fork City Council as follows:

1. The use of fireworks is prohibited anywhere within the development known as the Oaks and a half mile radius therearound.
2. A violation of this ordinance is a Class C misdemeanor.
3. It is a Class C misdemeanor for a parent or guardian to fail to supervise a child in their control or custody who is using fireworks in violation of this ordinance.
4. This ordinance is effective immediately and shall remain in effect through the balance of 1996.


