## ORDINANCE 17-96

### AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE PROVISIONS ON EXCAVATION TO REQUIRE INSURANCE

WHEREAS, Spanish Fork City requires contractors to obtained a permit prior to excavation, in any manner, upon any public street, right-of-way, or other public facilities; and

WHEREAS, in order to protect the interest, of the City it is reasonable that any contractor so obtaining such a permit should be required to obtain adequate insurance protecting the City from liability of any kind whatsoever;

NOW THEREFORE, be it ordained and enacted by the Spanish Fork City Council as follows:

SECTION I

Section 12.04.010 (B) (9) is hereby created to read as follows:

9. To provide proof of insurance satisfactory to the City consistent with coverages and amounts required by the City Construction and Development Standards. Said insurance shall also include a certificate which names the City as an additional insured.


