ORDINANCE 02-97

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING REQUIREMENTS OF BEER LICENCES

WHEREAS, Spanish Fork City has adopted an Ordinance regulating the sale of alcoholic beverages, including beer; and

WHEREAS, the Spanish Fork City Ordinance follows the requirements of state law in many instances; and

WHEREAS, changes in the state law require Spanish Fork City to amend it's ordinances to be in compliance with state law; and

WHEREAS, the regulation of alcoholic beverages is in the best interest of the residents of the City in order to protect their health, safety and welfare;

NOW THEREFORE, be it ordained and enacted by the Spanish Fork City Council as follows:

SECTION I

Section 5.12.070 (1)(b) the Spanish Fork City Municipal Code is hereby amended to read as follows:


B. It shall not permit beer, light beer, malt liquor, or malted beverages to be sold during the hours of 1:00 a.m. until 10:00 a.m., nor on Sundays.

This Ordinance shall become effective 20 days after publication.


