ORDINANCE 09-97

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE ANIMAL CONTROL ORDINANCE

WHEREAS, Spanish Fork City has enacted an Animal Control Ordinance regulating the conduct of animals within the City limits; and

WHEREAS, part of that ordinance deals with dogs chasing passersby; and

WHEREAS, it has come to the attention of the City that grammatical inaccuracies exist in part of the ordinance making the intent unclear; and

WHEREAS, in order to protect the health, safety, welfare of the residents of the City, it is important to have the intent of the ordinance made clear;

NOW THEREFORE, be it ordained and enacted by the Spanish Fork City Council as follows:

SECTION I.

Section 6.08.190 of the Spanish Fork City Municipal Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

6.08.190. Threatening Passerby.

It shall be unlawful for any dog to threaten passersby by nipping, chasing, jumping upon, attacking, or chasing any person, bicycle, or motor vehicle.


SECTION II.

SECTION III.


