## ORDINANCE 15-97

### AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE MUNICIPAL CODE CONCERNING NOMINATIONS FOR ELECTIVE OFFICE

WHEREAS, Spanish Fork City has enacted, as part of its Municipal Code, an ordinance outlining the procedure for nomination to elective office; and

WHEREAS, the 1997 Utah State Legislature amended the state law requirements for nomination to public elective office, thus requiring an amendment to the Spanish Fork Municipal Code;

NOW THEREFORE, be it ordained and enacted by the Spanish Fork City Council as follows:

Section 2.48.020(B) of the Spanish Fork Municipal Code is hereby amended to read as

follows:


B. To become a candidate for elective office at a November election of the City, a declaration of candidacy or nomination petition shall be filed with the City Recorder between July 15th and August 15th at 5:00 p.m.. In the event that August 15th falls on a weekend or a holiday, the deadline shall be extended to the next business day at 5:00 p.m. The declaration of candidacy shall comply with the form set forth in Utah Code Ann. §20A-9-203 (3) (1953 as amended).

THIS ORDINANCE SHALL BECOME EFFECTIVE 20 DAYS AFTER PUBLICATION.






