WHEREAS, Utah Code Ann. §41-6-104 mandates parallel parking unless a local ordinance authorizes angel parking; and

WHEREAS, the Spanish Fork City Engineering Department has determined that there are several areas within Spanish Fork City that the roads are wide enough that angle parking should be permitted and that by doing so parking would be increased and safety enhanced; and

WHEREAS, in those areas where angle parking does not create a hazard, striping should be done by the City to designate those areas where such parking can safely be permitted;

NOW THEREFORE, be it ordained and enacted by the Spanish Fork City Council as follows:

I.

Section 10.12.110 **Angle parking.** Is hereby created to read as follows:

10.12.110 Angle parking.

Angle parking is allowed in Spanish Fork City only where Spanish Fork City has striped the street to indicate angle parking is allowed. Cars may be allowed to park diagonally to the curb within the parking areas so striped. In all other locations on public street, the parking shall be parallel.

This Ordinance shall take effect 20 days after publication.






