ORDINANCE 15-98

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE ZONING ORDINANCE PERTAINING TO THE USES ALLOWED IN THE I-1 ZONE WITH A CONDITIONAL USE PERMIT

WHEREAS, Spanish Fork City has adopted a Comprehensive Zoning Ordinance which classified various types of zones; and

WHEREAS, Spanish Fork City has designated an I-1 light industrial zone; and

WHEREAS, Utah County owns various facilities located in the I-1 zone including the County Jail, the County Sheriff's Office, Central Dispatching; and

WHEREAS, Utah County also offers alcohol and other substance abuse treatment in a short term supervised residential setting, which it would like to operate in conjunction with the

existing facilities; and

WHEREAS, Spanish Fork City Planning Commission held a public hearing on the 4th day of November, 1998, to consider allowing such a facility in the I-1 zone as a conditional use; and

WHEREAS, following the public hearing, the Planning Commission gave a favorable recommendation for such a facility; and

WHEREAS, a public hearing was held before the Spanish Fork City Council on the 1st day of December, 1998, to receive public comment to further consider the matter;

NOW THEREFORE, be it ordained and enacted by the Spanish Fork City Council as follows:

I.

Section 17.08.020. of the Spanish Fork City Municipal Code is hereby amended to add a definition called "Residential Treatment Center" as follows:

Residential Treatment Center: A short term supervised residential treatment program for individuals who are abusing alcohol and/or other drugs. Services would typically include social detoxification; substance abuse education/coping/life skills classes; individual, group, and family therapy; and relapse prevention planning.

II.

Section 17.20.110 (C) (7) of the Spanish Fork City Municipal Code is hereby created to read as follows:

17.20.110. I-1 Light Industrial.

C. Uses Subject to Conditional Use Permit (See Chapter 17.12.080):

7. Residential Treatment Center.
