ORDINANCE 06-99

AN ORDINANCE ENHANCING THE ENFORCEMENT ABILITY FOR ILLEGALLY PARKED TRUCKS

WHEREAS, Spanish Fork City has adopted an Ordinance prohibiting the parking of large trucks or truck trailers on public streets in residential districts; and

WHEREAS, a number of trucks have been so parked recently; and

WHEREAS, parking of such trucks not only elicit a number of complaints from neighbors, but creates a serious safety hazard since it considerably narrows residential streets and obstructs the vision of other drivers; and

WHEREAS, the issuing of citations has not abated the problem; and

WHEREAS, in order to enhance public safety and make the residential streets safer, additional enforcement mechanisms are needed;

NOW THEREFORE, be it ordained and enacted by the Spanish Fork City Council as follows:

I.

Section 10.16.020 of the Spanish Fork Municipal Code is hereby amended by creating subparagraph (D) to read as follows:

- D. In addition to any other remedies available under this section, any truck or truck trailers parked illegally under this section, which has had a previous violation, may be impounded and towed. The requirements of chapter 10.12 shall be applicable to any such truck which is impounded.



Zone Change
(Hunters Crossing)

NOW, THEREFORE, be it ordained by the City Council of Spanish Fork City as follows:

The following described property is hereby zoned to Medium Residential (R-1-8): Commencing at a point located North 00° 24' 38" West along the Section Line 1007.90 feet and East 145.37 feet from the West quarter corner of Section 28, Township 8 South, Range 3 East, Salt Lake Base and Meridian, thence North 00° 31' 02" West along a fence line 330.49 feet; thence North 89° 41' 07" East partially along a fence line 1156.31 feet; thence South 00° 07' 00" West 591.39 feet; thence North 70° 19' 13" West partially along a fence line 465.61 feet; thence South 19° 58' 52" West along a fence line 153.77 feet; thence North 69° 52' 28" West 704.14 feet to the point of beginning.
