ORDINANCE 17-99

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE OUTDOOR BURNING REQUIREMENT OF THE SPANISH FORK MUNICIPAL CODE

WHEREAS, outdoor burning is closely regulated by the State of Utah, Utah County, and Spanish Fork City; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to amend the outdoor burning requirements from time to time in order to remain in compliance with State and County Law, and to protect the residents of the City; and

WHEREAS, the Spanish Fork Fire Department has determined that commercial barbeque pits pose a fire danger when operated in residential areas;

NOW THEREFORE, be it ordained and enacted by the Spanish Fork City Council as follows:

I.

Section 8.28.040 (B) is hereby amended to read as follows:

8.28.040. Outdoor Burning.

- B. Open burning shall be permitted in the following instances:
- i. In devices for the primary purpose of preparing foods such as outdoor grills, fireplaces, dutch ovens, and barbeque pits, provided any device used for the preparation of food must meet the minimum requirements as set forth in the Uniform Fire Code and the Utah State Division of Air Quality Regulations, and provided further that no commercial barbeque pits may be located in any of the residential zones of the City;
 - ii. Campfires and fires used solely for recreational purposes when such fires are under the control of a responsible person;
 - iii. In indoor fireplaces;
 - iv. Properly operated industrial flares for the combustion of flammable gasses.

In the event that the Spanish Fork City Fire Department receives a complaint of violation of any of the above instances, and an investigation by the Fire Department determines that there is a violation, the Fire Department may extinguish any such blaze or fire.

II.

This Ordinance shall take effect 20 days after passage and publication.





8.28.040. Outdoor Burning.

B. Open burning shall be permitted in the following instances:

- i. In devices for the primary purpose of preparing foods such as outdoor grills, fireplaces, dutch ovens, and barbeque pits, provided any device used for the preparation of food must meet the minimum requirements as set forth in the Uniform Fire Code and the Utah State Division of Air Quality Regulations, and provided further that no

commercial barbeque pits may be located in any of the residential zones of the City;

- ii. Campfires and fires used solely for recreational purposes when such fires are under the control of a responsible person;

iii. In indoor fireplaces;

- iv. Properly operated industrial flares for the combustion of flammable gasses.

In the event that the Spanish Fork City Fire Department receives a complaint of violation of any of the above instances, and an investigation by the Fire Department determines that there is a violation, the Fire Department may extinguish any such blaze or fire.
