RESOLUTION 99-12

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE ENTRY INTO AND EXECUTION OF A PAINT STRIPER INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT

WHEREAS, it is advantageous to the City to join with the other South Utah County Cities in purchasing a Paint Striper in order to complete striping projects within the City; and

WHEREAS, by combining resources with the other Cities, the City can obtain the use of a Paint Striper, which is used only a few days per year, at a much reduced cost, and can also share in the expertise of the personnel of the other Cities for such a project; and

WHEREAS, the Council has had an opportunity to review the document entitled Paint Striper Interlocal Agreement, which it finds it to be beneficial to the City;

NOW THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Spanish Fork City Council as follows:

1. The Mayor is hereby authorized to enter into a Paint Striper Interlocal Agreement and to execute the same, binding the City to the terms thereof.


