RESOLUTION 99-15

A RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING UNIFORM NONRESIDENT RECREATION FEES

WHEREAS, the City sponsors a recreation program for its residents; and

WHEREAS, the City subsidizes the recreation program from its general funds; and

WHEREAS, various nonresidents also participate in recreation programs; and

WHEREAS, it is neither fair nor equitable for nonresidents to pay the same fee as residents since the recreation program is subsidized; and

WHEREAS, it is fair and reasonable that all South Utah County Cities adopt a uniform policy in order to prevent an influx of a nonresident into any particular City, thereby causing

more serious problems;

NOW THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Spanish Fork City Council as follows:

1. All nonresidents participating in the recreation program with the City shall pay an additional \$20.00 fee per event with the exceptions set forth in the next paragraphs.
2. Cheerleading, swimming lessons, and tennis lessons, because of a smaller subsidization, will incur an additional \$10.00 fee per event.
3. There will be no extra charge for athletic camps, golf, or swimming.
4. This resolution shall become effective on the 1st day of July, 1999.


SECTION II
