ORDINANCE 02-00

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE BILLBOARD REQUIREMENTS OF SPANISH FORK CITY

WHEREAS, billboards are an important source of information, but if not properly regulated, can become an eyesore and a detriment to the City, and

WHEREAS, Spanish Fork City has adopted an ordinance which regulates billboards, and

WHEREAS, amendments are necessary from time to time in order to protect property values and the aesthetics of the community, and

WHEREAS, billboards are most effective when they adjoin an interstate or major highway, and

WHEREAS, a public hearing was held before the Spanish Fork City Planning Commission on the 2nd day of February, 2000 whereat a favorable recommendation was given; and

WHEREAS, a public hearing was held before the Spanish Fork City Council on the 7th day of March, 2000 wherein public comment was received,

NOW THEREFORE, in order to protect the health, safety, and welfare of the City of Spanish Fork, the Spanish Fork City Council hereby enacts and ordains the following ordinance:

I.

Section 17.~~12-070~~ (F) of the Spanish Fork City Municipal Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

F. Billboards.

Billboards are permitted in the following locations, subject to the following restrictions:

1. Billboards are permitted on I-15 from 3100 North to 1600 North and on U.S. Highway 6 from mile post number 177 (Highway 89) to mile post number 178 (heading south).
2. Must be within 100 feet of I-15 or US Highway 6.
3. Must be at least 750 feet from any other billboard on the same side of the highway.
4. Must be at least 400 feet from any residential district.
5. Cannot exceed a height of fifty (50) feet, or twenty-five (25) feet above roadway grade level, whichever is less.
6. May be double-faced or back-to-back if the separation of panels does not exceed five (5) feet.
7. Each side may have a sign area not to exceed 675 square feet.
8. Footing and structure details must be furnished to the City Building Official prior to issuance of a building permit.
9. Must be monopole.
10. Utah Department of Transportation must approve the billboard location prior to City approval.

II.

This ordinance shall become effective 20 days after passage and publication.


