RESOLUTION 00-20

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING A BALLOT PROPOSITION FOR A 1/4% SALES TAX FOR CONSTRUCTION AND MAINTENANCE OF HIGHWAYS UNDER THE JURISDICTION OF SPANISH FORK CITY

WHEREAS, Spanish Fork City is presenting a proposition to the voters in the November general election to withdraw from the Utah Transit Authority; and

WHEREAS, Utah Code Ann. §59-12-1001 allows a 1/4% sales and use tax to be imposed in those instances when there is no sales and use tax under § 59-12-501 for a public transit authority; and

WHEREAS, a 1/4% sales and use tax would generate approximately \$586,715.00 which could be used for construction and maintenance of City streets and roads; and

WHEREAS, an analysis conducted by the City shows that the City street and roads are in need of substantial maintenance over the next few years, which funds must be generated from increased taxes; and


WHEREAS, a transfer of the 1/4% sales and use tax from the Utah Transit Authority to maintenance of streets and roads, there would be no need for a tax increase;

NOW THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Spanish Fork City Council as follows:


1. A proposition shall be made to the electorate of Spanish Fork City at the November, 2000 general election to determine if 1/4% sales and use tax should be imposed for the purposes of construction and maintenance of highways under the jurisdiction of Spanish Fork City.
2. The Mayor and staff of Spanish Fork City are hereby authorized to take the necessary measures in order to place this proposition on the November general ballot and to follow the provisions of Utah Code Ann §59-12-1001 in order to present this proposition to the electorate of Spanish Fork City.

This resolution adopted this 18th day of July, 2000, by the City Council of Spanish Fork City, Utah.
