WHEREAS, Utah's culture is diverse due to the many ethnic groups that settled here; and

WHEREAS, Some of the early ethnic groups that helped settle the intermountain area include the Welch, Germans, Icelanders, English, Spanish, Africans, Scottish, French, Basques, Danes, Italians, Native Americans, Japanese, Greeks, Chinese, Polynesians, and Hungarians; and

WHEREAS, The Utah Western Heritage Foundation has, as its purpose, the preservation

of the unique cultural contributions to the intermountain area of various ethnic groups by promoting educational activities; and


WHEREAS, Many of the residents of Spanish Fork City are descendants of the early ethnic groups;

NOW THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Spanish Fork City Council as follows:


1. The week of September 3, 2000 be designated Utah Western Heritage Week in Spanish Fork City.
