RESOLUTION 02-07

A MAYORAL PROCLAMATION DECLARING MAY ELECTRICAL SAFETY MONTH

WHEREAS, hundreds of people die and thousands are injured each year in electrical accidents;
and

WHEREAS, the estimated deaths from residential electrical-related fires are more than four
hundred and eighty-eight lives annually; and

WHEREAS, one person is electrocuted in the home each day and five more each week in the
workplace; and

WHEREAS, property damage due to electrical-related fires amounts to nearly \$890 million each
year; and

WHEREAS, following basic electrical safety precautions can help prevent injury or death to

thousands of people each year; and

WHEREAS, citizens are encouraged to check their home and workplace for possible electrical hazards to help protect lives and property; and

WHEREAS, citizens are encouraged to test their smoke detectors and ground fault circuit interrupters monthly and after every major electrical storm; and


WHEREAS, the efforts of the Electrical Safety Foundation International (ESFI) and the U.S. Consumer Product Safety Commission (CPSC) promote and educate the public about the importance of respecting electricity and practicing electrical safety in the home, school, and workplace; and

WHEREAS, Spanish Fork City is actively helping to move this effort forward in order to reduce the number of electrical injuries and deaths from electrical hazards;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Dale R. Barney, Mayor of the City of Spanish Fork, do hereby proclaim May as Electrical Safety Month. This month observes the importance of establishing and practicing electrical safety habits in the home, school, and workplace to decrease electrical hazards, injuries, property damage and to prevent deaths.

I call upon the people of this Spanish Fork City to participate in Electrical Safety Month activities and to conduct an electrical safety check of their home, school, and workplace.
