RESOLUTION 02-09

A MAYORAL PROCLAMATION DECLARING THE ONE HUNDREDTH YEAR CELEBRATION OF THE BUREAU OF RECLAMATION

WHEREAS, the Bureau of Reclamation will celebrate its hundredth year of existence on June 17, 2002; and

WHEREAS, during this 100 years, the Bureau of Reclamation has constructed more than 600 dams and reservoirs and 58 power plants in 17 western states, leading to their economic development; and

WHEREAS, The Bureau of Reclamation is the largest wholesaler of water in the country, serving over 31 million people. The farmers and ranchers who receive reclamation project water have met the goal of providing food for the West; and

WHEREAS, The Bureau of Reclamation is the second largest producer of hydroelectric power in the western United States. Providing over 40 billion kilowatt hours of electricity, generating nearly a billion dollars in revenue, and producing enough electricity to serve 6 million homes.

NOW, THEREFORE, in recognition of the significance of the 100 years of service, support, and development the Bureau of Reclamation has provided the citizens of the United States of America, I, Dale R. Barney, Mayor of the City of Spanish Fork, do hereby proclaim June 17, 2002 as "Bureau of Reclamation Day."
