### ORDINANCE 02-03

#### AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE PARKING REQUIREMENTS ON MAIN STREET

WHEREAS, Spanish Fork City Main Street is a main commercial center for the City; and

WHEREAS, much of Main Street lacks off street parking, making parking along Main Street in commercial areas an important commodity for the Main Street business district; and

WHEREAS, individuals parking their vehicles along Main Street for half of the day and longer create a lack of parking for Main Street business customers; and

WHEREAS, limiting the time allowed for a vehicle to park on Main Street to three hours would be sufficient time to conduct any business along Main Street and accommodate the business

district and allow more people to access the businesses along Main Street; and

WHEREAS, Spanish Fork City Planning Commission has consulted with the Spanish Fork area Chamber of Commerce concerning the parking on Main Street and made various recommendations to the City Council;

NOW THEREFORE, be it ordained and enacted by the Spanish Fork City Council as follows:

### SECTION I

Section 10.16.010 Parking Prohibited of the Spanish Fork City Municipal Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

#### **10.16.010 Parking Prohibited.**

A. It shall be unlawful for any person to park any vehicle on either side of Main Street south of I-15 or north of 400 South between the hours of 11:00 p.m. and 5:00 a.m. It shall also be unlawful for any person to park a vehicle on either side of the street between the hours of 11:00 p.m. and 5:00 a.m. on Center Street between Main Street and 100 East, on 100 East between Center Street and 100 South, and on 100 South between 100 East and Main Street.


B. It shall be unlawful for any person to park any vehicle on either side of Main Street south of I-15 or north of 400 South, or on any of the side streets coming onto Main Street for one-half block east and west of Main Street for a period of time longer than three consecutive hours.

C. "Vehicle" is defined to include, but not necessarily be limited to, automobiles, trucks, trailers, mobile homes, travel trailers, boats, motorcycles, buses, snowmobiles, and other objects used or capable of being used for transportation purposes whether for the transport of humans, animals or freight of any kind.

**SECTION II**

This Ordinance shall become effective 20 days after passage and publication.
