ORDINANCE 03-03

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE PARKING REQUIREMENTS ON MAIN STREET

WHEREAS, Spanish Fork City has adopted a three hour parking limit on Main Street and on each side street for one-half block each side of Main Street; and

WHEREAS, the side street parking limit has proved more expensive than expected for signage and general enforcement; and

WHEREAS, the side street parking limit has proved to be inconvenient for residents of those side streets; and

WHEREAS, limiting the time allowed for a vehicle to park on Main Street to three hours

without imposing the same limits on the side streets accomplishes the purposes of the parking time limit;

NOW THEREFORE, be it ordained and enacted by the Spanish Fork City Council as follows:

SECTION I

Section 10.16.010 Parking Prohibited of the Spanish Fork City Municipal Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

10.16.010 Parking Prohibited.

A. It shall be unlawful for any person to park any vehicle on either side of Main Street south of I-15 or north of 400 South between the hours of 11:00 p.m. and 5:00 a.m. It shall also be unlawful for any person to park a vehicle on either side of the street between the hours of 11:00 p.m. and 5:00 a.m. on Center Street between Main Street and 100 East, on 100 East between Center Street and 100 South, and on 100 South between 100 East and Main Street.

B. It shall be unlawful for any person to park any vehicle on either side of Main Street, during other hours of the day, south of I-15 or north of 400 South for a period of time longer than three consecutive hours.

C. "Vehicle" is defined to include, but not necessarily be limited to, automobiles, trucks, trailers, mobile homes, travel trailers, boats, motorcycles, buses, snowmobiles, and other objects used or capable of being used for transportation purposes whether for the transport of humans, animals or freight of any kind.

SECTION II

This Ordinance shall become effective 20 days after passage and publication.
