ORDINANCE 08-03

AN ORDINANCE CLARIFYING THE POWER AND DUTIES OF THE CITY MANAGER

WHEREAS, Spanish Fork City has created the position of City Manager; and

WHEREAS, the City Manager has been assigned all of the administrative duties of the City,
which has included creating various policies of the City; and

WHEREAS, the duty to create those policies is implied in the Ordinance but should be
clarified; and

WHEREAS, it is most advantageous to the City and its residents to have a City Manager, as
an administrator, to create these administrative policies to assist the efficient operation of day to day
government;

NOW THEREFORE, be it ordained and enacted by the Spanish Fork City Council as follows:

I.

Section 2.16.020 (1) is hereby amended to read as follows:

SECTION 2.16.020. Power and Duties. (1) Faithfully execute and enforce all applicable laws, ordinances, rules, and regulations of the City, create and administer policies, rules, and regulations unless otherwise reserved to the Council, and see that all franchises, leases, permits, contracts, licenses, and privileges granted by the City are observed, having been delegated all administrative powers belonging to the Mayor and Council;

II.

This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon passage and publication.


