ORDINANCE 01-04

ORDINANCE AMENDING THE SPANISH FORK MUNICIPAL CODE CONCERNING THE APPOINTMENTS OF CITY FINANCE DIRECTOR/RECORDER AND CITY TREASURER

WHEREAS, the city finance director/recorder and city treasurer are offices required by state law

which are appointed by the mayor with the advice and consent of the city council; and

WHEREAS, the state law required the appointment following each municipal mayoral election, therefore, the city adopted an ordinance establishing the same criteria; and

WHEREAS, the 2003 legislature amended various sections of the state law, one of which requires the appointment of the city finance director/recorder and city treasurer following each

municipal election (U.C.A. section 10-3-916); and

WHEREAS, in order to remain in compliance with the state law, it is necessary to amend the city code to reflect the same changes;

NOW THEREFORE, be it ordained and enacted by the Spanish Fork City Council as follows:

I.

Section 2.20.010 Appointment. of the Spanish Fork City Municipal Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

On or before the first Monday in February following a municipal election there shall be appointed by the mayor, with the advice and consent of at least three (3) members of the city council, a city finance director/recorder who shall perform the duties required of him or her by law, the ordinances of the city and the State of Utah, and such other duties as the city council may, by resolution, require. The finance director/recorder shall serve until his/her successor is appointed, qualified, and sworn in.

II.

Section 2.24.010 Appointment. of the Spanish Fork City Municipal Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

On or before the first Monday in February following a municipal election there shall be appointed by the mayor, with the advice and consent of at least three members of the city council, a city treasurer who shall perform the duties required of him or her by law, the ordinances of the city and state of Utah, and such other duties as the city council may, by resolution, require. The treasurer shall serve until his/her successor is appointed, qualified, and sworn in.

III.

This ordinance is effective immediately upon passage.

WHEREFORE, to protect the safety and welfare of the citizens of Spanish Fork City, this ordinance shall take effect immediately upon passage.


