## RESOLUTION NO. 05-01

### A RESOLUTION ADOPTING THE USE OF THE NATIONAL INCIDENT MANAGEMENT SYSTEMS (NIMS).

WHEREAS, natural and man-made disasters have and may occur in any part of the City;  
and

WHEREAS, the majority of emergency incidents are handled and is litigated by City  
crews; and

WHEREAS, certain types of disasters may result in state and/or federal agencies being  
called upon to respond and/or assist in recovery from the effects of an emergency incident and  
disaster; and

WHEREAS, The Homeland Security Presidential Directive (HSPD-5 required federal  
departments and agencies to adopt the National Incident Management Systems); and

WHEREAS, in time of disaster, Spanish Fork City emergency preparedness crews may be required to work closely with state or federal agencies; and

WHEREAS, NIMS provides a consistent nationwide template for all agencies to work together to prevent, prepare for, respond to, and recover from all hazards; and

WHEREAS, as a condition for federal preparedness assistance, local organizations are mandated by HSPD-5 to adopt NIMS as the model for incident management in times of disaster, commencing in 2005; and

NOW THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Spanish Fork City Council as follows:


1. Spanish Fork City hereby adopts the National Incident Management System (NIMS) as its system in preparing for and responding to disaster incidents.
