RESOLUTION 06-12

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTION OF AN INTERLOCAL COOPERATION AGREEMENT TO CONTINUE THE CITY OF SPANISH FORK'S PARTICIPATION IN THE UTAH VALLEY CONSORTIUM OF CITIES AND COUNTY IN THE U.S. DEPARTMENT OF HOUSING AND URBAN DEVELOPMENT'S HOME INVESTMENT

WHEREAS, The City of Spanish Fork Municipal Council recognizes the need to provide decent, safe, sanitary, and affordable housing for low income families within Utah County; and

WHEREAS, the City of Spanish Fork, finds under the Interlocal Cooperation Act, Utah Code Annotated, Section 11-13-1 et. seq., 1953, as amended, that any two or more public agencies, as defined therein, may enter into agreements with one another for joint or cooperative action and may also contract with one another to perform any governmental service, activity, or undertaking which each public agency entering into the contract is authorized by law to perform; and

WHEREAS, the City of Spanish Fork, does hereby determine that it is in the public interest and welfare of the residents of Utah County, (hereinafter referred to as "the County"), that the County engage in a cooperative effort with cities located in the County by entering into an Interlocal Cooperation Agreement to form a consortium for the purpose of qualifying for and administering a United States Housing and Urban Development HOME Investment Partnerships Program (hereinafter referred to as "HOME Program"), and other associated activities and projects in the County; and

WHEREAS, the City of Spanish Fork, further finds that an Interlocal Cooperation Agreement (hereinafter referred to as "Agreement") covering federal fiscal years 2007, 2008, 2009 has been prepared for approval and execution by and between the participating parties including the City of Spanish Fork, and that said Agreement forms a consortium, states the purposes thereof, the extent of the required participation of the parties, and the rights, duties, and responsibilities and obligations of the parties in the conduct and administration of the HOME Program as specified therein.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SPANISH FORK, as follows

1. The Agreement, as attached hereto, entitled the HOME Investment Partnerships Interlocal Cooperation Agreement relating to the conduct of the Housing and Urban Development HOME Program for Federal Fiscal Years 2007, 2008, and 2009, is hereby accepted and approved by the City of Spanish Fork, and the Mayor is authorized to execute and the Recorder to Attest and seal the Agreement for and on behalf of the City of Spanish Fork.
2. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its approval and adoption.
3. This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon adoption.
