RESOLUTION 08-09

A RESOLUTION ALLOWING ANGLE PARKING IN DESIGNATED LOCATIONS

WHEREAS, Utah State law prohibits angle parking except where authorized by a local jurisdiction, and

WHEREAS, Spanish Fork Municipal Code §10-12-110 allows angle parking where the City has striped for angle parking; and

WHEREAS, the City has currently striped for angle parking at the Senior Citizens Center, City Library, Park School, and on 200 North from Main Street to 100 West, where the street right-of-way width allows angle parking to be implemented safely, and where there is a need for additional parking, and


WHEREAS, there has arisen a need for additional parking in other locations where the street right-of-way width will allow for the safe implementation of angle parking; and

WHEREAS, the businesses requesting additional angle parking are willing to incur the expense of relocating the curb in order to safely provide for angle parking;

NOW, THEREFORE, it is hereby resolved by the Spanish Fork City Council as follows:

1. Angle parking is allowed at the following additional locations:
 - a. On the south side of 300 South from approximately 50 West to approximately 100 West in front of the Nebo School District Warehouse;
 - b. On the south side of Center Street from 300 West to approximately 400 West, in front of the Spanish Fork Clinic;
 - c. On the north side of Center from 100 West to approximately 50 West, in front of Mountain High Credit Union.
2. The City streets department is hereby authorized and directed to stripe the streets for angle parking in these designated locations, as soon as necessary curb adjustments are made to safely implement angle parking.
3. This resolution is effective immediately.

This resolution adopted this 13th day of May, 2008, by the City Council of Spanish Fork City, Utah.
