### RESOLUTION 08-15

#### A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL APPOINTING MEMBER REPRESENTATIVE

#### Utah Valley Dispatch Special Service District.

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Utah County and several cities in Utah County initiated proceedings to create a special service district to provide consolidated 911 and emergency dispatch services within Utah County to be known as the Utah Valley Dispatch Special Service District (the "District"); and

WHEREAS, the Spanish Fork City Council adopted Resolution 08-13 which consented to the inclusion of area within Spanish Fork City; and

WHEREAS, the District will be governed by a Board of Directors and the Spanish Fork City Council desires to make a representative appointment to that Board;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF SPANISH FORK, UTAH, as follows:

1. That David Oyler, City Manager us hereby appointed as its representative to the

Utah Valley Dispatch Special Service District, together with such alternate or alternates as the Mayor shall appoint.

2. That this resolution shall remain in effect until repealed by another resolution appointing a different representative to the Utah Valley Dispatch Special Service District.
3. The provisions of this resolution shall take effect immediately upon passage.
