ORDINANCE NO. 10-11 ORDINANCE WAIVING THE SOLICITOR FEE FOR CHARITABLE ORGANIZATIONS

WHEREAS, Spanish Fork requires businesses to obtain a business license,
including solicitors; and

WHEREAS, Spanish Fork City charges a fee to offset its administrative costs for
business licenses; and

WHEREAS, charging a fee to persons soliciting on behalf of charitable
organizations reduces the amount, in the sum of the fee, that can be used for charitable
purposes; and

WHEREAS, it is desirable that charitable organizations with ties to the community

should receive as much in donations as possible;

NOW THEREFORE, be it ordained and enacted by the Spanish Fork City Council
as follows:

I.

Spanish Fork Municipal Code §5.04.110(F) is hereby amended as follows:

5.04.110. Fee Schedule


There is levied upon the business, location, trade, or calling of every person
engaged in business in the city an annual license fee based upon the type of class of said
business as follows:

F. The amount for a business license for a canvasser or a solicitor shall be \$100.00
per calendar year, unless the proceeds from the solicitation are only used for the benefit
of a charitable organization with substantial ties to the community. Such institutions shall
include, but not be limited to churches, scouting organizations, schools, service clubs, and
similar charitable organizations. For such charitable organizations, the license fee shall be
waived. No canvasser or solicitor license shall be valid during the period of the Fiesta
Days celebration.


II.
