## ORDINANCE NO. 16-11

### AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE FIRE AND AMBULANCE RETIREMENT ORDINANCE

WHEREAS, Spanish Fork City provides a Volunteer Fire Department and Volunteer Ambulance Association, which entities provide a valuable service to residents of the community; and

WHEREAS, Spanish Fork City maintains a retirement account on behalf of its qualified fire and ambulance personnel; and

WHEREAS, it is fair and reasonable, from time to time, to adjust the benefits in light of inflation and other factors;

NOW THEREFORE, be it enacted and ordained by the Spanish Fork City Council  
as follows: I.

Spanish Fork City Municipal Code §4.08.040 is hereby amended to read as  
follows:

**4.08.040. Retirement Benefit.**

The retirement benefit provided to each qualified firefighter or ambulance crew  
member shall be in the amount of \$100.00 per month through December, 2011.  
Commencing January 2012, the monthly amount shall increase to \$103.00 and shall  
increase in January each year thereafter by the monthly amount of \$3.00 for a period of  
ten years, until the retirement benefit amount reaches \$130.00 per month.


II.
