## RESOLUTION No. 13-06

### A RESOLUTION INCREASING THE PROPERTY TAX CERTIFIED TAX RATE FROM 0.001204 TO 0.001221

WHEREAS, Spanish Fork City's certified tax rate has been decreasing, due to the nature in which the State of Utah calculates the rate; and

WHEREAS, the City has fiscal needs which have gone unmet for several years as its residents have struggled with a national recession; and

WHEREAS, the local economy appears to have made significant strides toward a recovery, such that a small property tax increase can be tolerated by the residents; and

WHEREAS, the City Council, in its proposed fiscal year 2014 budget proposed leaving in place the 2012 certified tax rate, rather than the reduced certified tax rate submitted by Utah County, following the State of Utah formula; and

WHEREAS, a truth in taxation public hearing was scheduled for Tuesday, the 6<sup>th</sup> day of August, 2013, with notice published by Utah County in the Provo Daily Herald, a newspaper of general circulation in Spanish Fork City, on July 23 and 30, 2013, and

notice published by the City in the Provo Daily Herald on July 29, 2013, as well as being posted on the State Notice Webpage on July 27 and August 2, 2012 and on the City webpage on August 2, 2013; and


WHEREAS, a public hearing was held on Tuesday, the 6<sup>th</sup> day of August, 2013 before the Spanish Fork City Council in the council chambers, where no members of the public chose to address an increase in the certified tax rate by leaving the certified tax rate at the 2012 level; and

WHEREAS, in order to meet the fiscal needs of the City, it is in the best interests of the residents to maintain the certified tax rate at the 2012 level;


NOW THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Spanish Fork City Council as follows:

1. The certified tax rate for Spanish Fork City for 2013 will be 0.001221.
2. The City Finance Director is directed to process the necessary information and paperwork to implement the certified tax rate for 2013 as established herein.
