RESOLUTION No. 15-02

RESOLUTION CREATING A RENEWABLE ENERGY PROGRAM "RENEW CHOICE" AND ELECTRIC RATE SCHEDULE

WHEREAS, Spanish Fork City owns and operates its own electric division within the public works department to provide reliable electricity to its residents; and

WHEREAS, there is a growing interest among electrical costumers in the City expressing support and interest for renewable energy resources, and may elect to be "greener" in their resource mix and are willing to pay more for renewable resources than the lower cost traditional supplies of electricity; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to promote renewable energy for the betterment of the environment and give the choice to its electrical customers to pay an additional amount to receive renewable energy; and


WHEREAS, Utah Municipal Power Agency (UMPA) provides electricity to the City and has created a Renew Choice Program, which the City finds will allow its residents to purchase renewable energy; and

WHEREAS, the City has contracted with (UMPA) to participate in the Renew Choice Program as adopted by UMPA, in order to give its customers the opportunity to purchase renewable energy;

NOW THEREFORE be it resolved by the Spanish Fork City Council as follows:

1. Spanish Fork City hereby elects to participate in the Renew Choice Program as developed and adopted by Utah Municipal Power Agency and adhere to the conditions and terms of the program.
2. The Renew Choice program is available to all retail customers in all rate schedules. This program is voluntary and electric customers may choose to opt-in and purchase renewable energy in blocks of 100 kWh up to equal to their monthly consumption.
3. The City adopts \$2.00 per 100 kWh blocks of energy for any retail electric customer choosing to participate as the initial rate for Renew Choice Program. The rate will add \$2.00 per 100 kWh block per month rate to all existing charges within each rate structure. Changes in the Renew Choice rate will be adopted by resolution or in the adoption of the annual budget. The City will give notice to the Renew Choice customers 60 days in advance of any rate changes to Renew Choice approved by the City.
4. An electric customer must be current with their utility bill in order to participate in the Renew Choice Program. An electric customer that elects to participate in Renew Choice agrees to all the terms and conditions of the program. The election will become effective at the beginning of the next billing cycle. A customer may cancel or modify the blocks of Renew Choice by giving proper notice to the City at any time. The cancellation or modification will become effective as of the next billing cycle.
5. This resolution is effective on February 21, 2015.
