## RESOLUTION No. 15-10

### RESOLUTION OF SPANISH FORK CITY APPROVING AN INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT WITH UTAH COUNTY TO PROVIDE CASE MANAGEMENT SOFTWARE

WHEREAS, Spanish Fork City has a legal department which provides a prosecutor and staff to prosecute misdemeanor crimes committed within the City; and

WHEREAS, State court requirements concerning paperless filing has created additional work in the form of double entry requirements for the prosecutor and secretaries; and

WHEREAS, Case management software is available to eliminate the double entry requirements, but is very expensive; and

WHEREAS, Utah County, through the Utah County Attorney's Office faces the same dilemma and has proceeded to obtain the case management software and has made arrangements to make it available to cities in Utah County; and

WHEREAS, By entering into an interlocal agreement with Utah County, Spanish Fork will be charged user fees and will avoid the major cost of purchasing and installing the software; and


WHEREAS, using the case management software eliminates the prospect of hiring additional staff to address the increased workload;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SPANISH FORK COUNCIL, as follows:

1. The Interlocal Agreement between Spanish Fork City and Utah County, attached hereto, is approved and shall be executed by the City by signature of the mayor; and
2. Pursuant to Utah Code Annotated §11-13-202.5 (1953 as amended), said Interlocal Agreement shall be submitted to legal counsel of the City for review and signature indicating approval as to proper form and compliance with applicable law; and
3. Pursuant to Utah Code Annotated §11-13-209 (1953 as amended), a duly executed original counterpart of said Interlocal Agreement shall be filed immediately with the keeper of records of the City; and
4. The Interlocal Agreement shall become effective upon execution by Spanish Fork City and Utah County.
5. This Resolution shall become effective immediately.
