RESOLUTION OF SPANISH FORK CITY APPROVING AN INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT WITH UTAH COUNTY AND OTHER UTAH COUNTY CITIES TO PROVIDE MASS COMMUNICATION SOFTWARE

WHEREAS, Spanish Fork City has a need to contact all or large segments of its citizens in a quick and efficient manner, sometimes referred as reverse 911; and

WHEREAS, the City has been using a mass communications software for some time; and

WHEREAS, Utah County Dispatch Special Service District, Utah County, and other Utah County cities have begun using software known as Everbridge; and

WHEREAS, the City has researched Everbridge and find that it performs all of the necessary functions to work for Spanish Fork City at a reduced cost; and

WHEREAS, among the various functions of a mass communications software is the ability to contact residents in the event of an emergency; and

WHEREAS, in the event of an emergency throughout the County, it is important to be quick and efficient in disseminating information, for which a common mass communication tool is highly desirable; and

WHEREAS, Utah County Dispatch Special Service District is critical in disseminating information in the event of a regional emergency and desires to work with one mass communications tools versus several; and


WHEREAS, By entering into an interlocal agreement with Utah County and other Utah County cities, Spanish Fork will become more efficient and can also receive the benefit of volume discounts in purchasing the product;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SPANISH FORK CITY COUNCIL, as follows:

1. The Interlocal Agreement between Spanish Fork City, Utah County, and other Utah County cities desiring to participate, for mass communications software, attached hereto, is approved and shall be executed by the City by signature of the mayor.
2. Pursuant to Utah Code Annotated §11-13-209 (1953 as amended), a duly executed original counterpart of said Interlocal Agreement shall be filed with the City Recorder.
3. The Interlocal Agreement shall become effective upon execution by Spanish Fork City and either Utah County or another participating city located within Utah County.
4. This Resolution shall become effective immediately.


