

2004 Pool Resurfacing Project

The plaster surface at the swimming pool has deteriorated and needed to be replaced. The children's area was replaced earlier in the year. This project is to replace the surface on the rest of the pool.

This project will resurface the rest of the swimming pool at the Spanish Fork City Water Park. It involves about 13,900 square feet of plaster work.
