

ADOPTED MINUTES
SPANISH FORK CITY COUNCIL SPECIAL MEETING
FEBRUARY 27, 1989

COUNCILMEMBERS PRESENT: MAYOR J. MERRILL HALLAM, COUNCILMEMBERS THORA SHAW, JACK LEIFSON, AND REX WOODHOUSE. COUNCILMEMBERS HARRISON AND CHAPPLE WERE EXCUSED.

STAFF MEMBERS PRESENT: DAVID A. OYLER, CITY ADMINISTRATOR; CLYDE A. SWENSON, FINANCIAL DIRECTOR AND RECORDER; DEE ROSENBAUM, PUBLIC SAFETY DIRECTOR; JUNIOR BAKER, CITY ATTORNEY; LLOYD MILLER, FIRE CHIEF; AND DON THOMAS, AMBULANCE DIRECTOR.

COUNTY COMMISSIONERS PRESENT: BRENT MORRIS, SIDNEY SANDBERG, JERIL WILSON, UTAH COUNTY ATTORNEY'S OFFICE.

MAYOR HALLAM OUTLINED THE CONCERNS THE CITY HAS ABOUT FIRE AND AMBULANCE CALLS IN THE COUNTY.

MR. OYLER WENT OVER THE BUDGET FIGURES OF THE FOLLOWING ITEMS: FIRE AND AMBULANCE CALLS MADE IN THE COUNTY. THE COUNTY REPRESENTATIVES AND OTHER JOINED IN THE DISCUSSION AS TO THE ACTUAL NUMBER OF CALLS MADE AND REPORTED. A FIVE YEAR AVERAGE WAS TALKED ABOUT.

CLARIFYING AREAS OF RESPONSIBILITY WAS ALSO DISCUSSED. THE COUNTY REPRESENTATIVES SAID THEY WOULD GO OVER THE CONCERNS THAT WERE DISCUSSED AFTER ACCUMULATING MORE INFORMATION AND WILL GET BACK WITH CITY OFFICIALS IN APPROXIMATELY ONE MONTH.
