

**ADOPTED MINUTES
SPANISH FORK CITY COUNCIL MEETING
JULY 5, 1990**

The meeting was called to order at 7 pm by Mayor Marie W. Huff. The Pledge of Allegiance was said under the direction of Councilmember Gordon.

Councilmembers Present: Mayor Marie W. Huff, and Councilmembers Thora L. Shaw, Sheldon A. Gordon, and Rex Woodhouse. Councilmembers Jerald Chapple and T. Page Harrison were excused.

Staff Members Present: David A. Oyler, City Administrator; Richard Heap, City Engineer; Dee Rosenbaum, Public Safety Director; Paul Larsen, Building Inspector; Junior Baker, City Attorney; and Mary-Clare Maslyn, Administrative Assistant.

Citizens Present: LeAnn Moody, The Daily Herald and Spanish Fork Press, and Ann Banks.

Members of the Community Theatre Board informed the council of the status of "Seven Brides for Seven Brothers", the Fiesta Days musical. Councilmembers were invited to attend this event.

Minute Passage

The minutes for the July 5, 1990 meeting, along with warrants received a **motion** of passage by Councilmember Woodhouse. A **second** was made by Councilmember Woodhouse. The motion **passed** with a unanimous vote.

Canyon View Boys School

The item of the Canyon View Boys School was tabled until the July 18, 1990 meeting due to the request of Canyon View Services.

Forbush Quit Claim Deed

The Quit Claim Deed for the Forbush property was discussed. Councilmember Shaw **motioned** to allow the Mayor to sign the deed. Councilmember Woodhouse **seconded** the motion, and the motion **passed** unanimously.

Handicap Group Home - Ordinance 11-90

The Public Hearing for Handicap Group Home was held. City Attorney Junior Baker discussed this ordinance in detail and referred to state laws. Ordinance 11-90 received a **motion** for passage by Councilmember Shaw, and a **second** by Councilmember Gordon. The motion **passed** with a unanimous vote.

Jahabow Company Agreement

Oyler reviewed the agreement between the Jahabow Company and the city. Councilmember

Gordon **motioned** to allow Mayor Huff to sign the agreement. A **second** was given by Councilmember Shaw and the motion **passed** unanimously.

Water Development Engineer Agreement

The Water Development Engineer Agreement was discussed. With the provision that Councilmember Harrison would review the document provided by Hall, Bedke, and Berrett, Councilmember Woodhouse **motioned** to allow the Mayor to sign the document. A **second** was received by Councilmember Shaw. The motion **passed** with a unanimous vote.
