

**ADOPTED MINUTES
SPANISH FORK CITY COUNCIL MEETING
JULY 18, 1990**

The meeting was called to order at 7 pm by Mayor Marie W. Huff. The Pledge of Allegiance was under the direction of a local Boy Scout.

Councilmembers Present: Mayor Marie W. Huff, and Councilmembers Jerald M. Chapple, Thora L. Shaw, Sheldon Gordon, and T. Page Harrison. Councilmember Woodhouse was excused for a UMPA meeting.

Staff Members Present: David A. Oyler, City Manager; Clyde A. Swenson, Finance Director and Recorder; Junior Baker, City Attorney; Paul Larsen, Building Inspector; and Mary-Clare Maslyn, Administrative Assistant.

Citizens Present: Kim Peterson, Virginia Evans, Two scout leaders and three boy scouts, Mr. and Mrs. Leon Abbott, Mr. Kim Thorn, Craig Huntington, Dr. Roby, Dr. Huntington, Mr. Canyon, and a member of Miss Payson royalty.

Minute Passage

Councilmember Harrison **motioned** to accept the minutes of the July 5, 1990 meeting with indicated changes. The **second** was made by Councilmember Chapple. The motion passed **unanimously**.

Miss Payson Royalty

A member of Miss Payson's royalty invited the council to their city celebration, Onion Days.

Kim Peterson - Fiesta Days

Kim Peterson, Fiesta Day's chairperson, presented the Councilmembers with Fiesta Days t-shirts. He also invited the council to all activities which will take place July 21, 23, and 24.

Canyon View Services Boys School

Mr. Kim Thorn, Craig Huntington, Dr. Roby, Dr. Huntington, and Mr. Canyon, members of the Canyon View Services Boy School, approached the council regarding building a facility in Spanish Fork City. Details of the facility and the young men who will be housed there were discussed. The principle question in the discussion was whether or not the facility was a school as defined by the council. City Attorney Baker reviewed the question of qualification of a school. The age of the individuals who would be housed at this facility will be 12 - 18 years of age/males. A **motion** was made by Councilmember Harrison to table the item so the council may receive more information by visiting a similar facility. A **second** was made by Councilmember Shaw, and the motion **passed** unanimously.

Water Funding

The council was informed that the city will be submitting applications for funding for safe drinking water. A **motion** was made by Councilmember Harrison allowing such submission to occur. Councilmember Shaw **seconded** the motion, and the voting was unanimous for **passage**.

Abbott Annexation - Public Hearing

The Public Hearing was held on the Abbott Annexation. Councilmember Chapple **motioned** to accept the annexation with the inclusion of the strip of land by Butler's and behind Abbott's plus the areas shaded on the map to be zoned RA-1. Councilmember Gordon **seconded** the motion, and the motion **passed** with a unanimous vote.

Work Sessions

Mr. Oyler discussed with the council the option of holding work session meetings on the second Wednesday of each month. The council will begin such meetings on August 8th.

The meeting adjourned at 8:25 pm.
