

**ADOPTED MINUTES
SPANISH FORK CITY COUNCIL MEETING
AUGUST 1, 1990**

The meeting was called to order at 7 pm. The Pledge of Allegiance was lead by Councilmember Harrison.

Minute Passage

A **motion** was made by Councilmember Shaw to accept the minutes of the July 20, 1990 City Council Meeting with indicated changes, along with presented warrants.

A **second** was made by Councilmember Woodhouse, and the motion **passed** with a unanimous vote.

Youth Baseball League Sponsorship

Jim Nelson, representing the Babe Ruth League Baseball team thanked the council for what they have done for the athletic and recreation programs in the city. He also asked for donations to help the team travel to California. A **motion** to give the team was \$100 was made by Councilmember Chapple, and a **second** was made by Councilmember Woodhouse. The motion **passed** with a unanimous vote.

Park Improvement - Blanche Jensen

Blanche Jensen addressed the council concerning beautification of the City Park and placement of more playground equipment. She presented plans she has had drawn up by a landscape architect. She was told that the city would try to implement some of the recommendations that were presented.

Boys School Neighborhood Opinion

A group of citizens from the East Bench area were in attendance to receive information about the requested Canyon View boys School for the area. Wendi Whitehead was the spokesperson and read a prepared statement opposing this school. She presented a petition signed by residents in the general area. The group sponsoring the school was allotted ten minutes to clarify their position. Some questions were asked and answered between the groups. The council stated that a decision would be made in the council meeting of August 15, 1990, as to whether the school would be allowed in the area.

Weed Abatement Bid Award

A **motion** was made by Councilmember Woodhouse to accept the low bid submitted by Arlo Mitchell to clean up three properties that had been advertised. A **second** was made by Councilmember Chapple, and the motion **passed** with a unanimous vote.

Price Savers Credit Approval

A **motion** was made by Councilmember Shaw to allow Spanish Fork City to set up a credit account with Price Savers. The limit will be \$2,500.00. Items would be purchased there that could be advantageous to the city. A **second** was given by Councilmember Woodhouse. The motion **passed** unanimously.

Safe Sidewalk Grant

Richard Heap told the council that a Safe Sidewalk Grant had been obtained from the State in the amount of \$25,000.00 to be used on 4th North going west from 3rd West. Work would be done on both sides of the street. Some city money would be added to this. A **motion** was made by Councilmember Shaw to authorize Mayor Huff to sign the UDOT agreement. A **second** was given by Councilmember Harrison, and the motion **passed** unanimously.

Ordinance 12-90 - Revision of Title 9

City Attorney Junior Baker reviewed Ordinance 12-90 with the council. This is a revision of our present criminal code to eliminate duplication and adopt by reference State Statutes that apply to the city. Some changes were recommended by the City Council. A **motion** was made by Councilmember Shaw to adopt the revised ordinances. A **second** was made by Councilmember Gordon, and voting was unanimous for **passage**.

Fiesta Days Review

Councilmember Shaw expressed thanks for the efforts of city staff and committees for a very successful Fiesta Days celebration. She especially emphasized the ideas and promotional activity efforts put forth by Mary-Clare Maslyn.

Executive Session

A **motion** was made by Councilmember Shaw to go into executive session at 8:35 to consider a personnel matter. A **second** was made by Councilmember Gordon. The voting was unanimous.
