

**Adopted Minutes
Spanish Fork City Council Meeting
January 16, 1991**

The meeting was called to order at 7:20 pm by Mayor Marie W. Huff. The meeting began late due to a speech by President Bush regarding the offensive attack of U.S. forces in the Persian Gulf.

Elected Officials Present: Mayor Marie W. Huff, Councilmembers Jerald M. Chapple, Thora L. Shaw, Sheldon A. Gordon, Rex Woodhouse, and Sheldon A. Gordon.

Minute Passage

Councilmember Harrison made a **motion** to accept the minutes of the January 5, 1991, Council Meeting, with stated deletions. The **second** was made by Councilmember Woodhouse, and the motion **passed** unanimously.

Used Police Car Bid

Finance Director Swenson presented information on a used car for public safety detectives. Lieutenant Bradley Stone explained the procedure used to choose their car. After discussion, Councilmember Shaw made a **motion** to accept a bid from Barber Brothers for a Chevrolet Lumina at **\$9,650**. A **second** was made by Councilmember Woodhouse, and the motion **passed** unanimously.

Eagle Scout Project - Sign Inventory

Heath Braunfield, an eagle scout candidate, presented his project to the council. Mr. Braunfield took an inventory of all the signs in the city and told of their condition. He was thanked by the mayor and by all councilmembers. Mary-Clare Maslyn was instructed to prepare a certificate of appreciation for the scout.

Allred and Olsen Annexation Petitions

The Allred and Olsen petitions for annexation were reviewed. Councilmember Shaw made a **motion** to accept both the Allred and Olsen petitions for consideration by the Planning and Zoning Commission. The **second** was made by Councilmember Chapple, and the motion **passed** unanimously.

Ordinance 91-01: Revisions for Titles 12, 13, 14

Attorney Baker presented the Ordinance 91-01 - Revisions for Titles 12, and 13, with 14 being combined in these titles. After suggestions for clarity were presented, Councilmember Shaw made a **motion** to table the item until the February 6, 1991 council meeting. Councilmember Woodhouse made the **second**, and the motion **passed** unanimously.

Mid-Year Budget Revision

The FY 91 mid-year budget revision will be held on February 6th at 8 pm.

Recycling Program

A recycling program was spoken of. Ken Swenson of Swenson Metals is beginning to accept certain articles for recycling. Also, Terry Casto has been chosen by the city to be the recycling specialist of

the community.

Miscellaneous

Councilmember Shaw congratulated Dave Oyler on his new membership for the Mountain View Hospital Planning Committee.
