

**Adopted Minutes  
Spanish Fork City Council Special Meeting  
November 26, 1991**

The meeting was called to order at 1 pm by Mayor Marie W. Huff.

Elected Officials Present: Mayor Marie W. Huff, and Councilmembers Jerald M. Chapple, Thora L. Shaw, Sheldon W. Gordon, Rex Woodhouse, and T. Page Harrison.

Staff Members Present: David A. Oyler, City Manager; Richard J. Heap, City Engineer; kent R. Clark, Finance Director/Recorder; and Jeff Foster, Electric Superintendent.

**900 North Power Line**

A discussion was held concerning the overhead power lines on 900 North. Jeff Foster presented the concerns pertaining to the compliance with the National Electric Safety code regarding distances from structures. He indicated that the closest structure was far within the safety standards pertaining to distances. Dave mentioned that we had contacted the FHA Office and spoke with Mr. Tillotson, he indicated that he would provide, in writing, the position of FHA pertaining to the power lines.

**Video**

Those in attendance watched a video which showed similar power lines located in Provo, Orem, Springville, and Mapleton.

**Opinions Concerning 900 North Power Line**

After the video, Mayor Huff asked each councilmember to express their opinion concerning the location of the power line. Each councilmember indicated that it was their preference to leave the power line on 900 North, with the exception for Mr. Harrison who indicated that he preferred the line should be placed elsewhere.

The 900 North location of the power line is where it has been planned by the electric department for many years. Funding for the project was approved when the FY 1992 budget was passed.
