

**Adopted Minutes**

**Swimming Pool Information Meeting**

Mayor Huff asked Recreation Director Jack Swenson to provide information dealing with the proposed new swimming pool. Mr. Swenson presented the public and council information about an outdoor pool. Information regarding the cost of a covered pool was also presented. The pool architect, David Brims, presented the drawings of the pool and answered questions.

High School Principal commented that the school is supportive of the pool and the district would donate the property for the pool.

Duane Barney told the public of his plans for building a Holiday Inn Motel on the north side of town. The motel would have an indoor pool and the public could use in for a small fee.

Members of the general public asked questions about the design. A group of senior citizens asked why the pool was not covered. It was explained that cost was the main factor. Not only the added construction cost, but also the added operating cost. It was explained to have an indoor pool the city would have to have a bond election and raise the property tax rate. Other indoor pools in the state are heavily subsidized by the city or county they are owned by.

Lorraine Davis read a statement for the council to consider. She is seeking the council to consider a recreation center similar to American Fork City's.

Council asked the staff to gather information on a bubble cover for the pool.

**1994 Fiscal Budget**

Mr. Oyler reviewed again with the council the proposed budget with the council. Council discussed the use of city reserves. Public Hearing set for June 2, 1993.
