

Adopted Minutes
Spanish Fork City Council Meeting
May 17, 1995

The meeting was called to order by Mayor Marie W. Huff at 6:30 pm for a preliminary review of the agenda. At 7:00 pm the pledge of allegiance was lead by Patrick Gleaves.

Elected Officials Present: Mayor Marie W. Huff, and Councilmembers Clyde A. Swenson, Thora L. Shaw, Kim H. Peterson, and Jerald M. Chapple. Councilmember Rex Woodhouse was excused.

Minutes

Councilmember Chapple made a **motion** to approve the minutes of the May 10, 1995, regular city council meeting. The **second** was made by Councilmember Peterson, and the motion **passed** with a unanimous vote.

Employee of the Quarter

Mayor Huff presented Heather Frost with the Employee of the Quarter award for the first quarter of 1995.

Citizen Request - Kim Chappel

Mr. Kim Chappel presented a citizen request to rename the portion of Kirby Lane running east and west in front of Chappy's Chevron and the proposed continuation of that road to Chappel Lane. The council discussed Mr. Chappel's request.

Councilmember Shaw made a **motion** to rename and also give a number to the portion of Kirby Lane running east and west in front of Chappy's Chevron, as well as the proposed continuation of that road to "Chappel Drive". The **second** was made by Councilmember Swenson, and the motion **passed** with a unanimous vote. Councilmember Chapple abstained from voting.

Citizen Request - Summer Celebration

Mrs. Phyllis Peterson presented plans of the Utah South County Community Action Team to hold a "Summer Celebration" on the last night of school to give school-age youth of Spanish Fork fun, organized, and low cost, last day of school celebration activities. She said some businesses in town are offering reduced prices for activities; such as Duke's Lanes Bowling Alley, Main Street Movie, and Jim's Video. Other businesses are donating money to assist in the costs incurred by the Utah South County Community Action Team. She said they are looking for more financial support to possibly allow the activities to be free to the children.

The council agreed it is a very good idea to hold this event. They suggested contacting the Chamber of Commerce for additional assistance from businesses.

Citizen Recognition - Mike Edwards

Mayor Huff and the council presented Mr. Mike Edwards with a certificate of recognition and a gift and expressed their appreciation for his outstanding community service.

Jensen Subdivision - Preliminary

Mr. Heap reviewed the preliminary. He said the Development Review Committee recommends approval.

Councilmember Swenson made a **motion** to approve the Jensen Subdivision - Preliminary. Councilmember Peterson **seconded**, and the motion **passed** unanimously.

Amy Subdivision - Preliminary

Mr. Heap explained this is a revision of the original preliminary making lot two into lots two and three. He said the Development Review Committee and the Planning Commission recommend approval with the following conditions: 1) The sewer line is realigned; and 2) An additional fire hydrant is installed.

Councilmember Peterson made a **motion** to approve the Amy Subdivision - Preliminary. The **second** was made by Councilmember Chapple, and the motion **passed** with a unanimous vote.

Vineyard Subdivision

Mr. Heap pointed out the location of the subdivision. He said the irrigation ditch will have to be piped or letters of abandonment will have to be received before final plat approval.

Councilmember Swenson made a **motion** to approve Vineyard Subdivision - Preliminary. The **second** was made by Councilmember Shaw, and the motion **passed** unanimously.

Election Judges for the 1995 Spanish Fork City General Obligation Bond Election

A **motion** was made by Councilmember Shaw to accept the election judges as presented for the 1995 bond election. Councilmember Chapple **seconded**, and the motion **passed** with a unanimous vote.

Adjournment

Councilmember Shaw made a **motion** to adjourn the meeting at 8:00 pm. The **second** was made by Councilmember Chapple, and the motion **passed** with a unanimous vote.
