

**Adopted Minutes**  
**Spanish Fork City Council Meeting**  
**January 4, 2000**

The meeting was called to order at 6:30 pm by Mayor Dale R. Barney for a preliminary review of the agenda. At 7:00 pm the pledge of allegiance was led by local boy scout Tyler Ferre.

**Oath of Office for Newly Elected Officials**

City Recorder Kent R. Clark administered the oath of office of Councilmembers Sherman E. Huff, Glenn A. James, and Roy L. Johns.

**Appointment of Mayor Pro Tempore**

Mayor Barney recommended Councilmember Sherman E. Huff be appointed as the Mayor Pro Tem.

Councilmember Kelepolo made a **motion** to appoint Councilmember Sherman Huff as the Mayor Pro Tem. Councilmember Shepherd **seconded**, and the motion **passed** with a unanimous vote.

**Ordinance 01-00: An Ordinance Amending the Duties of Private Club License Holders**

Attorney Baker reviewed proposed Ordinance 01-00 to amend the duties of private club license holders. Staff would like to require establishments holding a Class C liquor license to keep a daily log of members and guests who enter the premises. It is felt this will allow for easier police enforcement, with less intrusion for the permit holder. Attorney Baker also noted the ordinance will be amended to not allow any person under age 21 on the premises.

Councilmember Huff asked the consequences of violating the ordinance. Attorney Baker indicated an enforcement mechanism in place would be to schedule a hearing with the Council to review and potentially revoke the establishment's liquor license.

Councilmember Huff made a **motion** to adopt Ordinance 01-00: Amending the Duties of Private Club License Holders. Councilmember Johns **seconded**, and the motion **passed** with a unanimous vote.

### **Adjournment to Executive Session**

Councilmember Shepherd made a **motion** to adjourn the regular session of the Spanish Fork City Council at 7:27 pm, and convene the executive session to discuss legal issues. Councilmember Kelepolo **seconded**, and the motion **passed** with a unanimous vote.
