

**Adopted Minutes**  
**Spanish Fork City Council Meeting**  
**June 18, 2002**

The meeting was called to order at 6:30 pm by Mayor Dale R. Barney for a preliminary review of the agenda. David A. Oyler offered a prayer. At 7:00 pm the pledge of allegiance was led by Kent Clark.

**Minutes**

Councilmember Johns made a **motion** to approve the minutes of the June 11, 2002 city council meeting, as presented. Councilmember Christensen **seconded**, and the motion **passed** with a unanimous vote.

**Agenda Request - Parking Problem at 91 East 200 North - Howard Creer**

Mr. Creer addressed council concerning a parking problem in front of his home located at 91 East 200 North. Mr. Creer said he is aware the area is available for public parking and he has no problem with main street patrons parking for a couple of hours to shop or eat. However, Mr. Creer said it is inconsiderate for employees in the area to park for eight to twelve hours in front of his home when parking is available at their places of employment.

Mayor Barney said another parking problem was addressed during the previous city council meeting and is currently being considered. Mayor Barney told Mr. Creer the parking problem he has brought to council's attention will also be considered.

**Public Hearing - Fiscal Year 2002 Budget - Final Revision**

Councilmember Huff made a **motion** to move out of the regular session of city council meeting and into the public hearing for the fiscal year 2002 final budget revision. Councilmember Kelepolo **seconded**, and the motion **passed** with a unanimous vote.

Mayor Barney reviewed the procedures for a public hearing.

Mr. Oyler reviewed the final revision of the fiscal year 2002 budget.

Mayor Barney open the meeting for public input. None was given. Mayor Barney opened the meeting for council discussion.

Councilmember Johns said Mr. Oyler has spent many hours putting together the budget and the city should be pleased with the results.

Councilmember Kelepolo made a **motion** to accept the fiscal year 2002 final budget revision as presented. Councilmember James **seconded**, and the motion **passes** with a unanimous vote.

### **Redevelopment Agency**

Councilmember Huff made a **motion** to move out of the city council public hearing portion of the meeting and move into the Redevelopment Agency meeting. Councilmember Kelepolo **seconded**, and the motion **passed** with a unanimous vote.

### **Other Business**

Mayor Barney received a letter from a resident asking if everyone using pressurized irrigation water would be metered. Mayor Barney said, yes, everyone use pressurized irrigation water next year will be metered.

Councilmember Kelepolo made a **motion** to adjourn. Councilmember Huff **seconded**, and the motion **passed** with a unanimous vote. The meeting adjourned at 7:45 pm.
