

**Approved Minutes

Canvass of Election Recount

Mr. Clark said after the general election there was only a two-vote difference between the second council seat, after the provisional ballots were counted there was an eight-vote difference that changed the Councilmember-elect. Mr. Hill asked for a recount. There were 15 election judges brought in to perform the recount. After the recount the results showed Steve Leifson as the top vote getter and Wayne Andersen as the second top vote getter. After the review and the council certifies the canvass the newly elected officials will be sworn in at the first January meeting.

Mr. Clark said the documents are signed by each election judge.

The Mayor and City Council then reviewed the election canvass.

Councilmember Kelepolo made a **motion** to approve the Election Canvass as presented. Councilmember Sorensen **seconded** and the motion **passed** unanimously.

Adjournment to Executive Session

Councilmember Sorensen made a **motion** to move into an Executive Session to discuss land acquisition issues. Councilmember Kelepolo **seconded**, and the motion **passed** with a unanimous vote. The meeting adjourned at 4:13 p.m.
