RE: Angle Parking on streets

Presently State law does not allow angle parking without the local authority specifically allowing it by resolution.

We have allowed it at a few locations (Senior Citizens, Library, Park School and on 200 North from Main to 100 West).

We recommend that the City Council allow angle parking on 300 South at the Nebo School District Office, on Center Street at the Spanish Fork Clinic at about 300 West at on Center Street at Mountain High Credit Union. All three locations can accommodate this style of parking with the present R/W width. The School District Office site will have to move the curb and gutter back closer to the sidewalk. They are expanding the District Offices and need additional parking. People have parked at the Clinic on an angle for years. We want to stripe that area so that it provides for 45 degree parking. Right now they are parking every which way including 90 degrees to the roadway which requires the vehicles to back out farther into traffic. Mountain High Credit Union also needs additional parking and would like to redo their curb and gutter to something similar to the Senior Citizens.
