**CALL TO ORDER, PLEDGE, OPENING CEREMONY, RECOGNITION:**

Mayor Leifson called the meeting to order at 6:00 p.m.

Motivation/Inspirational Message given by Paul Brickson.  
Councilman Scoubes led in the pledge of allegiance.

**PUBLIC COMMENTS:**

Lana Creer-Harris expressed that she felt the cemetery looks like the west desert. The grass is dead in many places and she would like something done.

Cary Hanks, Director of the Spanish Fork/Salem Area Chamber of Commerce, gave an update on the play unplugged program.

**COUNCIL COMMENTS:**

Councilman Gordon said that he attended a meeting with the Solid Waste District and the same struggles continue with the green waste and are looking at a centralized location. He said regarding the cemetery he was told that one of our workers mixed some generic poison, on accident, on three full blocks. He expressed that the Sexton and his workers are sincerely sorry. Dale Robinson said that the City had consulted with many turf experts and are going to reseed the areas. If we need to we will sod some areas. Discussion was held regarding the dead grass.

Dale Robinson apologized to the residents on behalf of the Parks and Recreation.

Councilman Gordon said that the play unplugged program is very fun and that his family is embracing it.

Councilman Davis expressed that he loved the cemetery and thanked everyone that helped with the crosses. He said that we have a great City and that he knows that the cemetery will get

fixed. He said the Fiesta Days Committee is working hard and the theme will be "I Love This Town." The Champions Challenge was great and expressed thanks to everyone that helped.

Councilman Dart gave a shout out to Dale Robinson and the Parks and Recreation staff pulling off the Champions Challenge Rodeo. The cowboys love to come to Spanish Fork. He said that it was a great event.

Councilman Mendenhall expressed gratitude for the unplugged program and everyone who participated.

Mayor Leifson said that people really did not know what the Champions Challenge Rodeo was and expressed what a great event it was and the hospitality that the City provides the cowboys.

Dale Robinson said that the event would be televised on Sunday June 8th at 7:00pm on CBS Sports. He said that he spent a lot of time with the camera crews and they had nothing but good to say about Spanish Fork City. He thanked all of the volunteers, the Rodeo Committee, and everyone who pitched in.

Councilman Scoubes expressed how great the reading program was and that 45,000 hours were read among the children.

Mayor Leifson said that there was a biker memorial ride for Cory Wride this past Saturday. Mayor Leifson had the opportunity to present Nannette Wride with one of 200 pictures of the New York Skyline from 9-11. He thanked Chief Adams and the police department for their assistance with traffic.
