III. Projects Update

Dale used a power point presentation to update the committee members on the projects that are underway this fall in the department. Nelson field is undergoing some renovation. We are replacing the infield in order to get it level along with portions of the baselines. We are replacing the existing curb at the cemetery with standard curb & gutter. There is water damage to the asphalt on the roads as a result of poor drainage. The roads will receive an overlay as well. This will be done in phases over the next 4 years. We are realigning the roads at Canyon View Park as well as expanding the parking areas and adding a trail. The entrance will be more gradual and will have a nice landing area where you can see both ways onto powerhouse road. The road in the park will be two way traffic and portions of the old road will become part of the trail. Festival of Lights traffic will now go on the exterior of the park and use a portion of the trail so as to alleviate the bottle neck we used to have. We will also be getting a new rodeo arena at the fairgrounds. The demolition will begin in the next couple weeks. Construction of the new structure is slated to be completed by June 1. This will provide more seating capacity with greater comfort. It will also include new restroom and concession facilities.

IV. Main Street Banners

The city has approved the use of the main street banners on a trial basis this year for city sponsored events only. The poles and cables are already in place with one on the north end and one on the south end of town. Dale will get with Doug Ford to coordinate the banners.

V. Other Business

Susan asked if there was still money available to pay for the story boards that were planned at the pioneer cemetery. She will be the one putting together the information that will go on them. The city will follow through on having those made and installed.
