

## VALID VOTER IDENTIFICATION IS

One **(1)** of the following:

A currently valid:

- Utah driver license;
- ID card issued by the state; or a branch, department, or agency of the US government;
- Utah permit to carry a concealed weapon;
- United States passport; or
- Tribal identification card (with or without a photograph).

**OR**

Two **(2)** of the following showing name and at least one of them with the current address of the voters place of residence within the voting precinct.

- Certified birth certificate;
- Valid Social Security card;
- Check issued by the state or federal government;
- Paycheck from the voter's employer;
- Currently valid Utah hunting or fishing license;
- Currently valid US military ID card;
- Certified naturalization document;
- Currently valid license issued by an authorized agency of the U.S.;
- Certified copy of court records showing adoption or name change;
- Bureau of Indian Affairs card;
- Valid Medicaid, Medicare, or Electronic Benefits Transfer Card;
- Currently valid ID card issued by: local government within Utah; an employer; a college, university, technical or professional school located within Utah;
- Currently valid vehicle registration; or
- Any of single source documents above establishing, ID and residence within the voting precinct.
