Rules and Regulations:

- **AUDITION SUBMISSION DEADLINE:** On or before Monday, May 23, 2016 – 5:00 p.m.
- **HOW TO SUBMIT:** Via email (electronically) to lewwoolford@gmail.com or mail or drop off DVD to Spanish Fork Parks & Recreation, 775 North Main, Spanish Fork, UT 84660. All submissions must include: your name(s), address, all phone numbers and emails where you may be contacted.
- **FINALISTS:** SFGT Selection Committee will select 12-15 "ACTS" to perform at the Spanish Fork City Park Library Stage on Friday, July 22, 2016 beginning at 6:30 p.m.
- **PERFORMANCE TIME LIMIT:** All performance audition submissions and live performances may not exceed five minutes.
- **JUDGING:** Will be done by a panel of three judges.
- **AGES AND TALENT TYPE:** 5 to 75 may compete in any talent – vocalists, musicians, jugglers, magicians, comedians, poets, vocal ensembles (not more than four singers), acoustic instrumental ensembles (not more than four members) and dance groups (no more than twelve participants).
- **REGISTRATION & WAIVER:** There is no cost to participate, but you will be required to sign a performance waiver if you are selected as a finalist as you will be filmed by SFCN.
- **SUBMISSION RESULTS:** You will be notified by June 10, 2016 if you are chosen as a finalist.
- **FINALISTS:** If you are selected to be a finalist, you must be available to perform in the SPANISH FORK'S GOT TALENT FINAL SHOWCASE on Friday, July 22 on the Library Stage at the Spanish Fork City Park, beginning at 6:30 p.m. (Note – the stage surface is cement.)
- **JUDGING CRITERIA:** You will be judged on these categories: Talent, Performance, Appearance, and Audience Rapport. 1st Place Winner will receive \$300; 2nd Place Winner, \$200 and 3rd Place Winner, \$100. All finalists will receive medals.
